It is not uncommon for the teacher to hear children to ask for more work time as the end of the work cycle. It is a joy for teachers to hear this request.

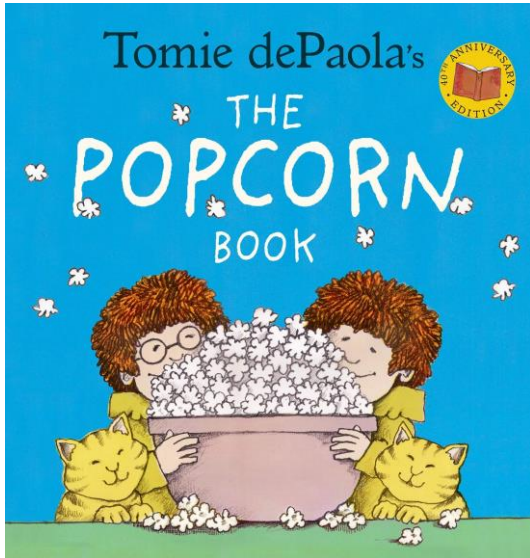
